

Panchpran

Introduction:

Panchpran is a term that Prime Minister Narendra Modi used in his Independence Day speech on August 15, 2022. He announced a development strategy for the next 25 years of India, which he called 'Panchpran'. It means 'five vital forces' or 'five pledges' for India's future.

According to Honorable Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi, India has to focus on five areas in the coming years. These are:

- A developed India: The Prime Minister emphasised the need to move forward with bigger resolutions for a developed India. He said that initiatives like cleanliness campaigns, vaccination drives, electricity connection to 25 million people, stopping open defecation and focusing on renewable energy sources are being taken up to achieve this.
- **Freedom from the idea of servility:** PM Modi also stressed on erasing all traces of servitude in order to change the people's mindset. According to Modi, the National Education Policy (NEP) is the way to get rid of the mentality of servility. He said, "We should be proud of every language of the country" and praised the rise of digital India. He also said start-ups are the result of the emerging power of the country.
- **Pride in heritage:** In order to give solutions to the issues in the world, it is necessary to take pride in our own heritage, said the prime minister. He further said, "When we connect with our earth, only then will we fly high. Protection of the environment is hidden in our heritage."
- Unity and solidarity: Prime Minister Modi said that unity and solidarity can be achieved by celebrating diversity. Respecting women, gender equality and respect for workers are part of celebrating diversity. He also spoke strongly against the discrimination against women and said citizens must strive to find a way out of this issue.
- **Fulfilling one's duty:** As a part of the development strategy, PM Modi also emphasized the duty of the citizens towards the country. He said, "The duty of citizens paves the way for progress. This is the basic vital force." He added that it is not just the common man who must fulfill this duty but the union ministers, including the prime minister himself.



Guidelines on Public Self-Disclosure by Higher Education Institutions

National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 emphasizes transparent selfdisclosure by Higher Education Institutions (HEIs). Public self-disclosure by HEIs, in fact, is one of the fundamental principles of the policy. NEP contemplates that HEIs shall be responsible and accountable to the stakeholders through transparent self-disclosure of all relevant records.

2. The availability of information in the public domain is an important source of accountability.

3. Stakeholders in the higher education system such as students, parents, research scholars, prospective students, regulatory bodies, accreditation agencies, alumni, and the public desire to seek information from the websites of HEIs.

4. Every Higher Education Institution shall maintain a functional website for making relevant self-disclosure to the stakeholders. The disclosure made on the website shall have unrestricted access without any requirement of log-in/registration and shall have a 'Search' facility for easy access.

5. Higher Education Institutions may provide information related to the following on their websites and provide the links, wherever possible:
